About seminar theme

The main goal of documentation and standardization of ethnomedicine is to discover novel compounds, used in indigenous medical systems. These phytochemicals can be employed in the development of new pharmaceuticals. Chhattisgarh is a remarkable place because of its flora and fauna. Here the tribal have their unique Ethnomedicinal practices and beliefs. Because of its dense forests and natural resources including some rare species of medicinal plants Chhattisgarh has been declared as Herbal State.

The traditional healers of Chhattisgarh administer the roots, rhizomes, bark, leaves, flowers, fruits, latex and seeds of medicinal plants that grow in the forest regions of their territories. The medicinal components of these plants have been recognized and validated through a trial-and-error process. This know-how has been incorporated into an ethno-healing system based on the traditional wisdom of the tribes accumulated over generations. Peers transfer the knowledge and use of these herbs from one generation to another.

However, the indigenous knowledge of the tribal communities of Chhattisgarh is yet to be appropriately explored and documented. Therefore it is very important to document this traditional wisdom and standardized the useful herbal formulations. This will help in acknowledgement of indigenous knowledge of Chhattisgarh and also create opportunities for further studies and economic development of the rural population.

Objectives and importance of the Event

- ❖ Exploration of Indigenously used herbal formulations of Chhattisgarh State.
- ❖ To recommend the methods of documentation of Ethnomedicinal practices of this region to the State Govt. and NGOs.

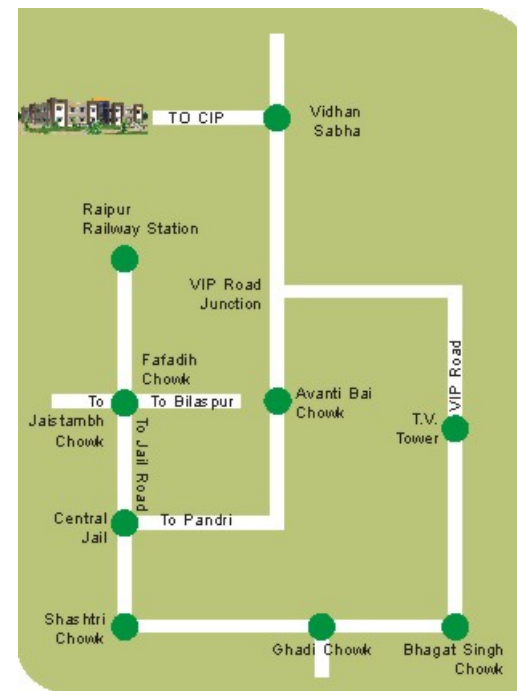
